Dear Senators and Representatives,

We have just celebrated the International Human Rights Day, December 10 and we will be celebrating the UN International Migrants' Day on December 18.

These are very significant days among migrants all over the world and in particular for Filipinos overseas in various countries, these are benchmark days in celebrating and reflecting on our human rights as migrants.

During these days, therefore, we urge all members of the Bicameral Conference Committee as well all the legislators of the 12th Congress to calendar and effect the immediate passage of the Absentee Bill.

15 years have passed since this right of suffrage has been guaranteed and mandated in our 1987 Constitution.

7 million overseas have been demanding the fulfillment of this fundamental right of suffrage. As part of the International Coalition for Overseas Filipinos' Voting Rights (ICOFVR) we look forward to the immediate legislation of the Absentee Voting Bill this Christmas 2002. PANAHON NA!
